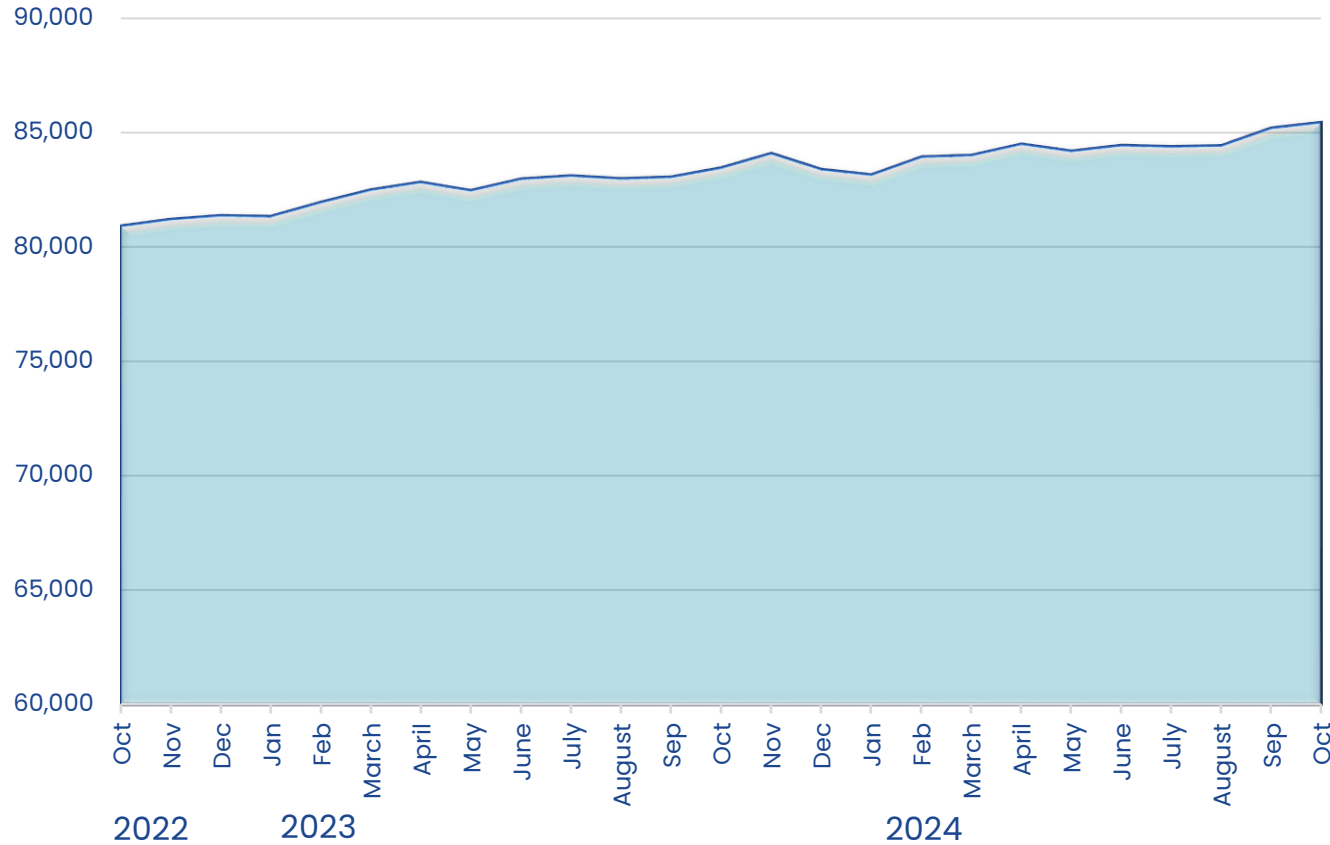

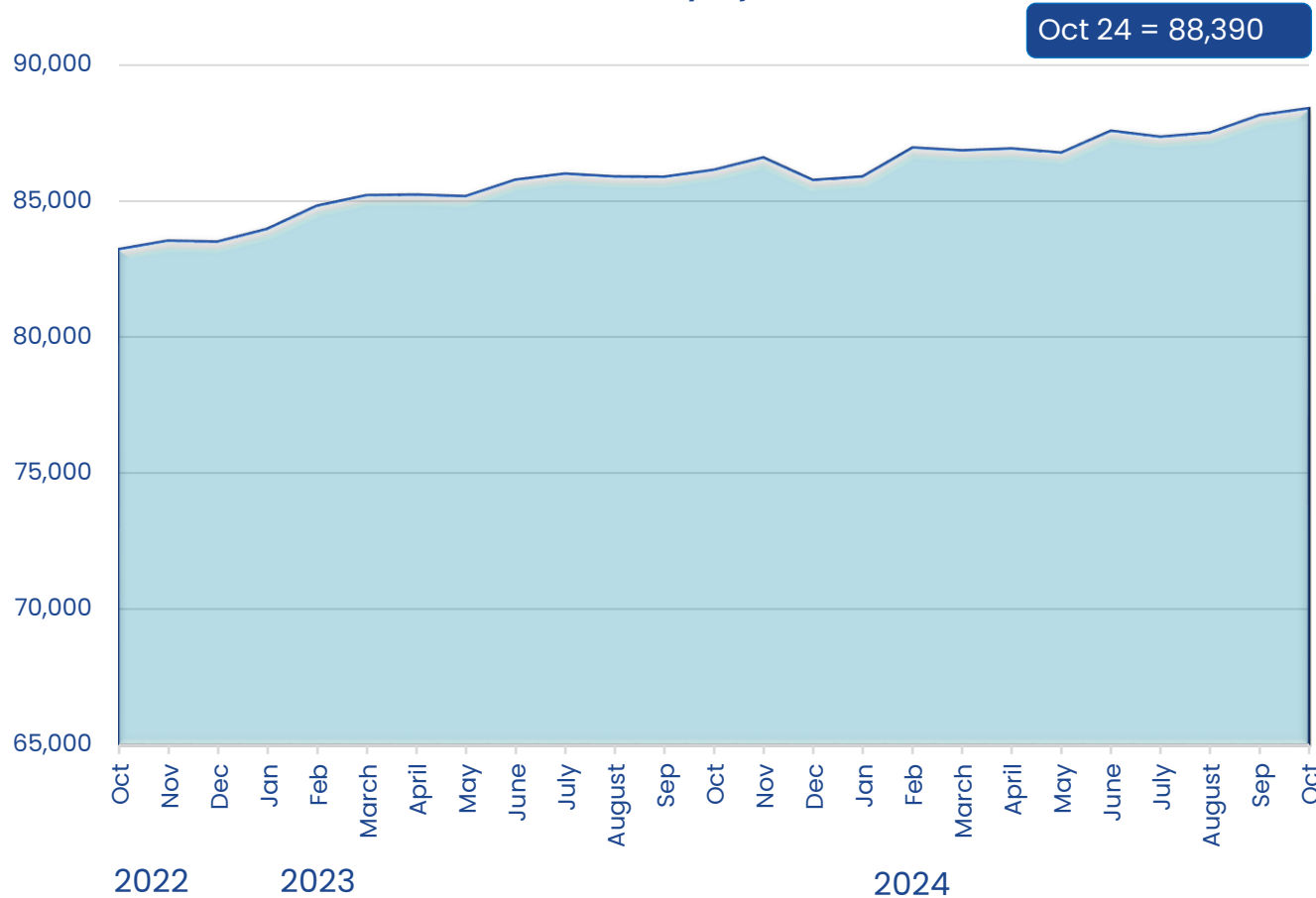

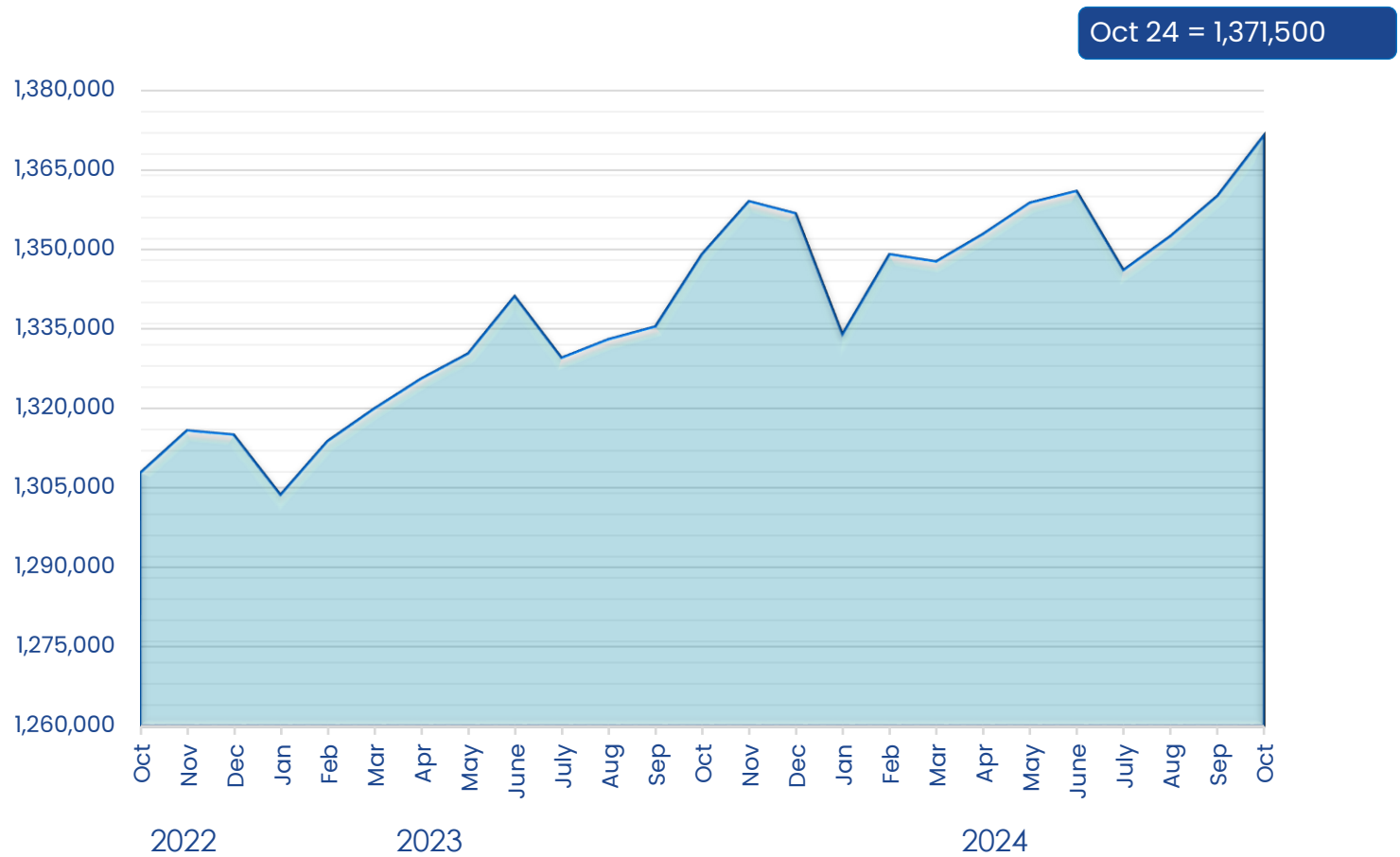

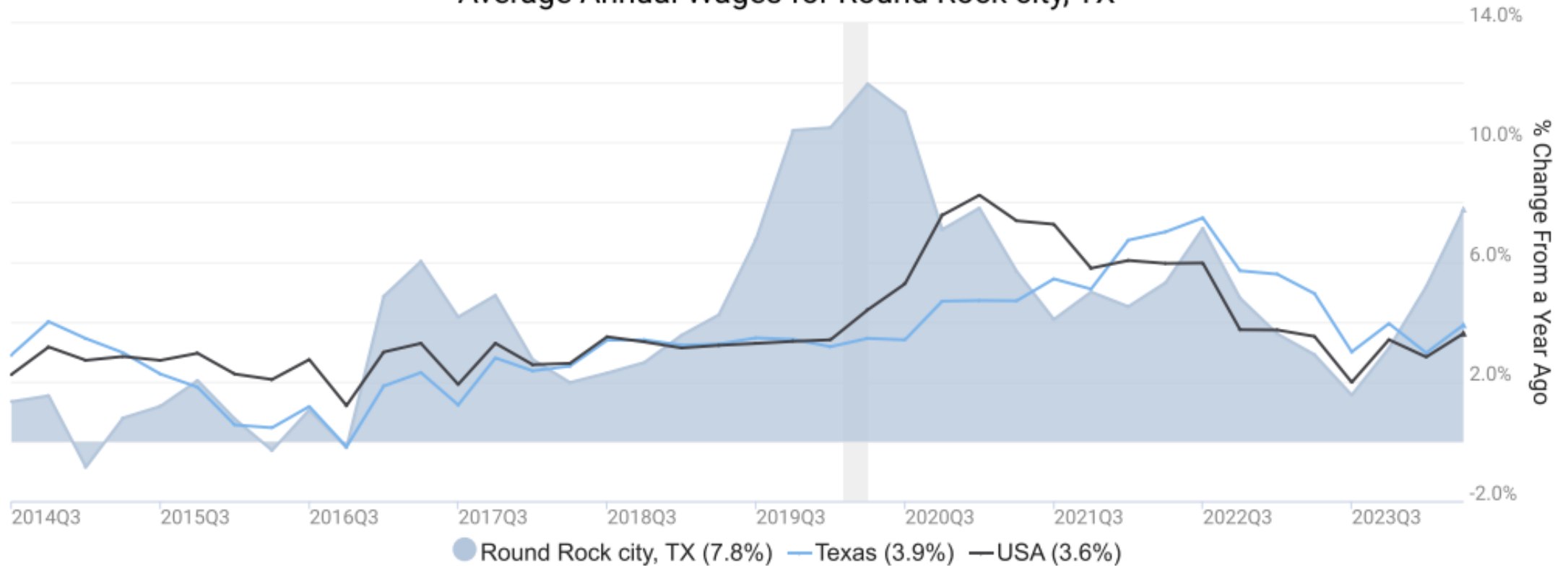

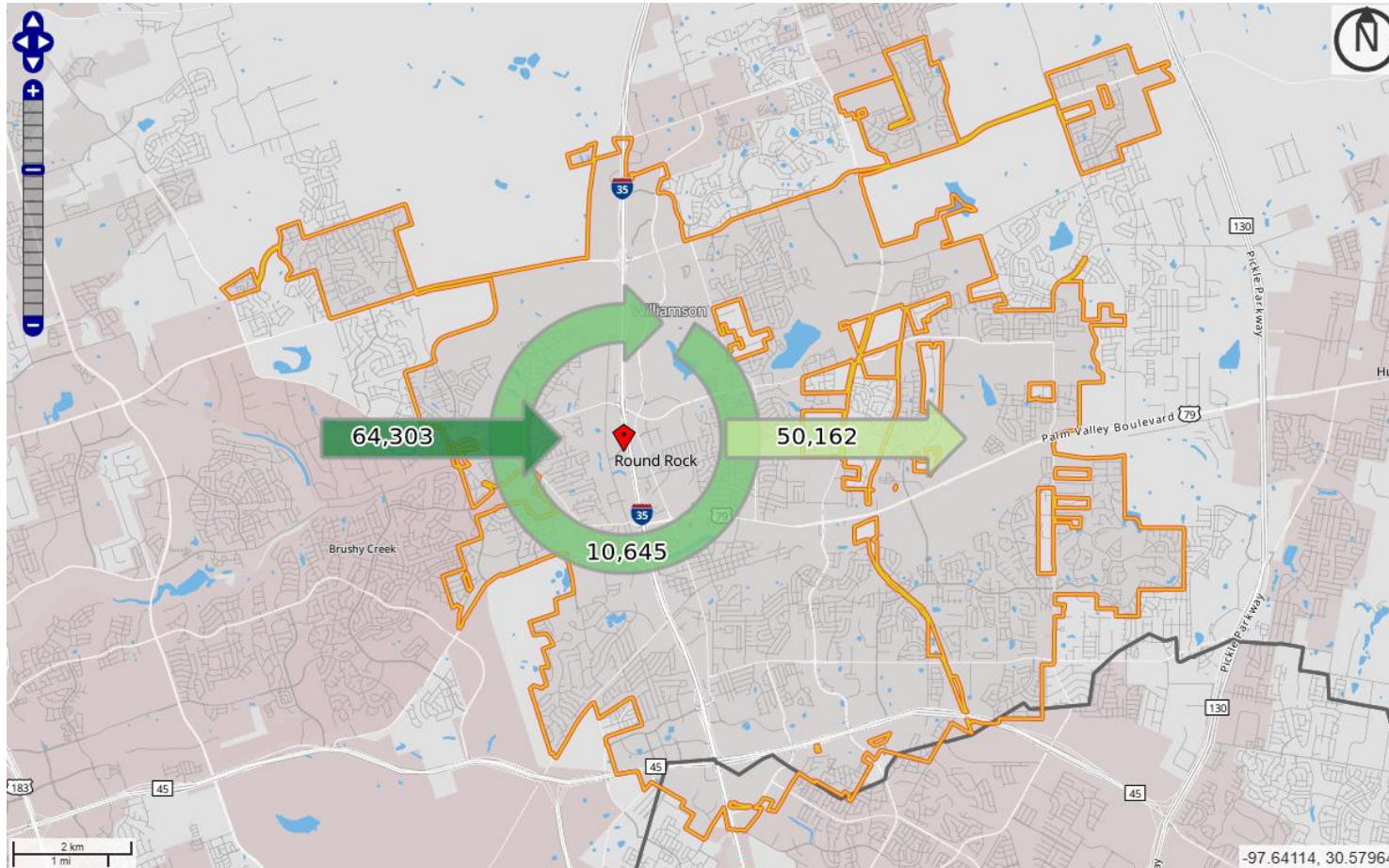

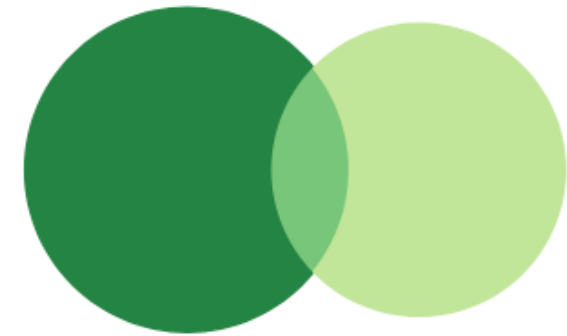


# US Census: Inflow/Outflow Primary Job Counts in 2022 for City of Round Rock

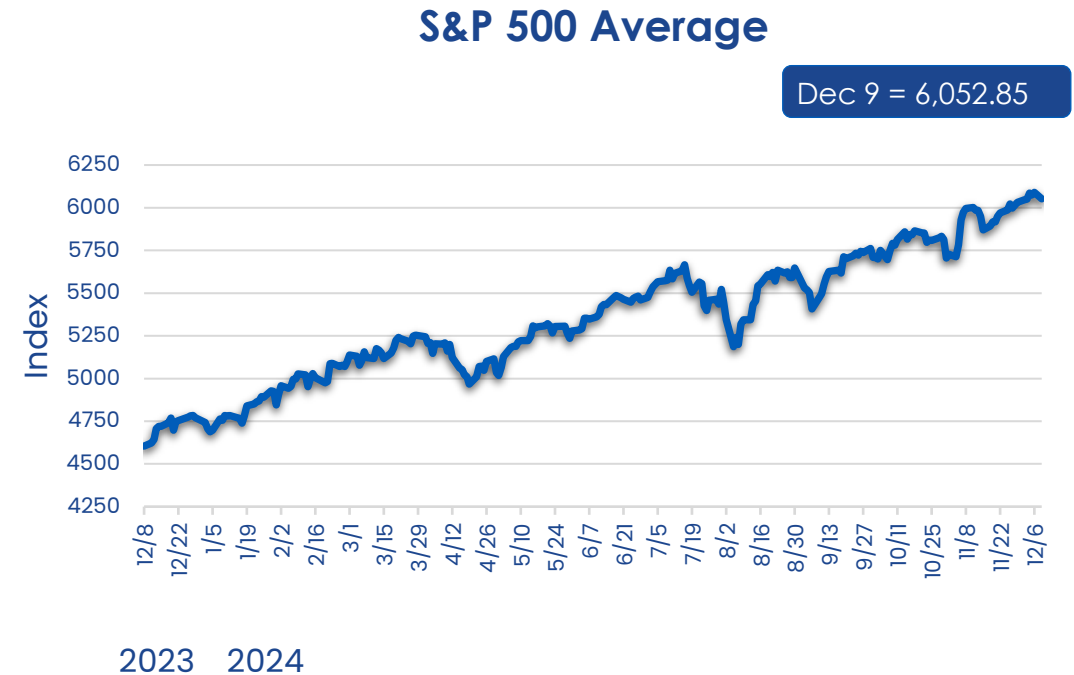

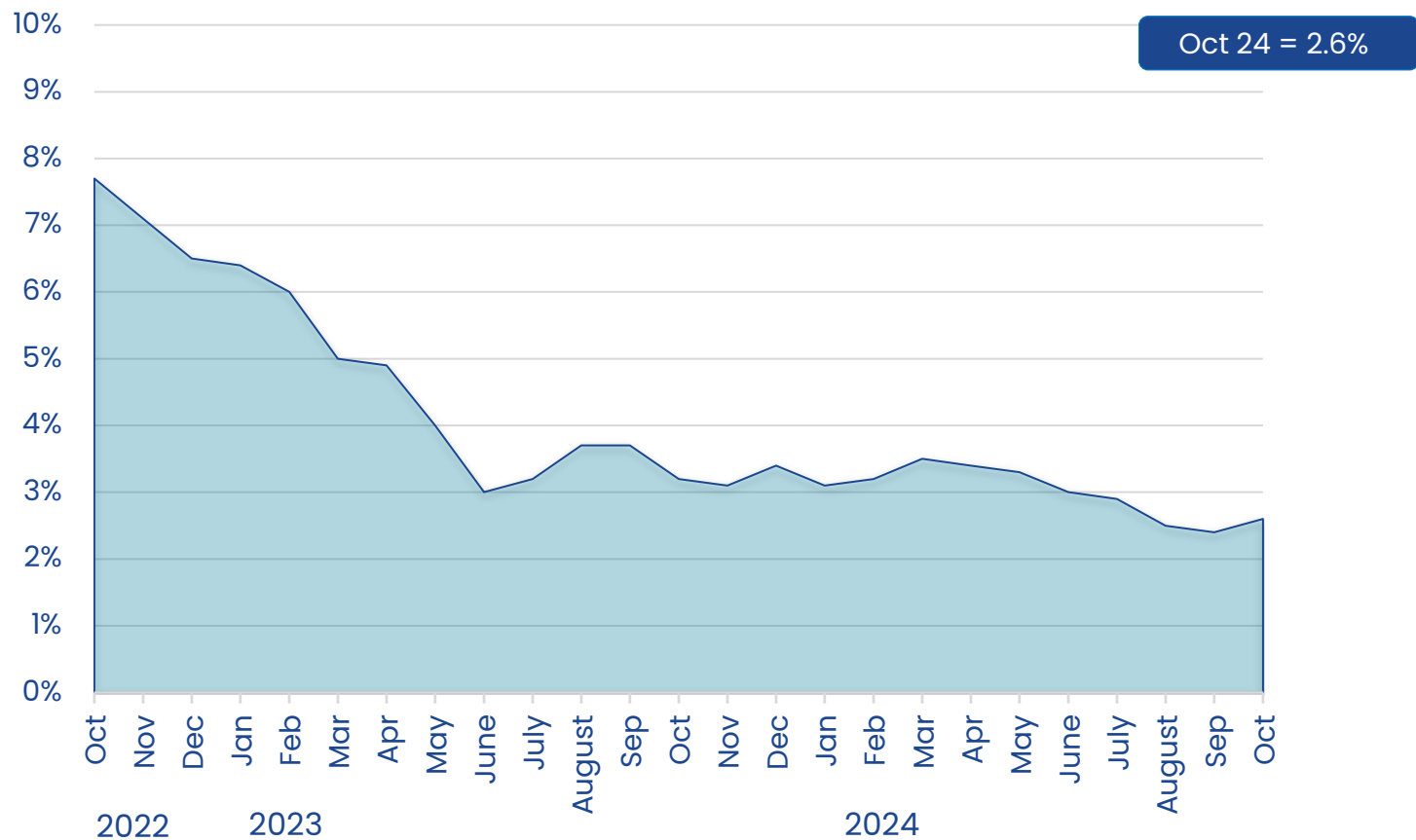

CPI-U\*, 12-month percent change, not seasonally adjusted, All Items

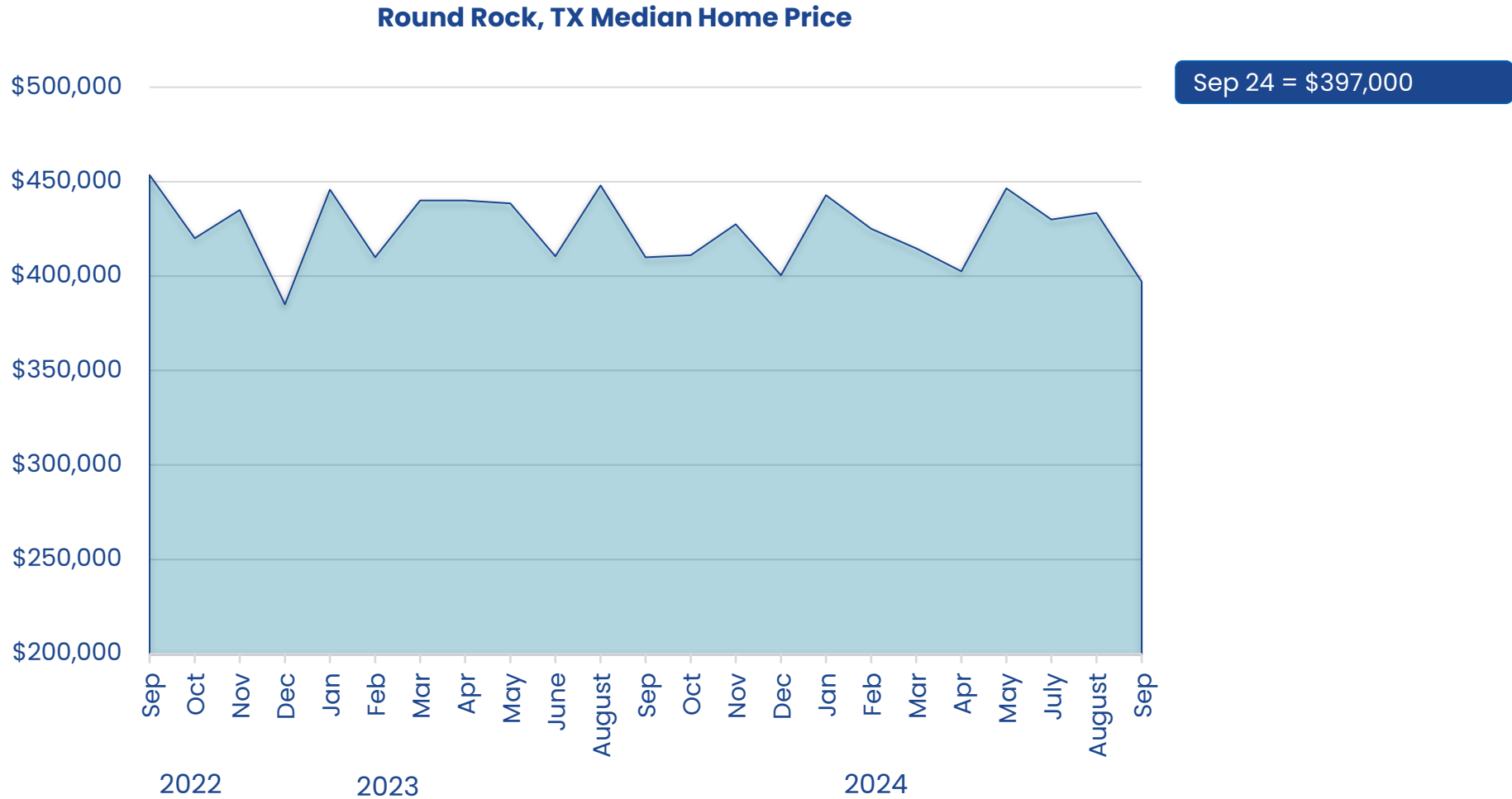
