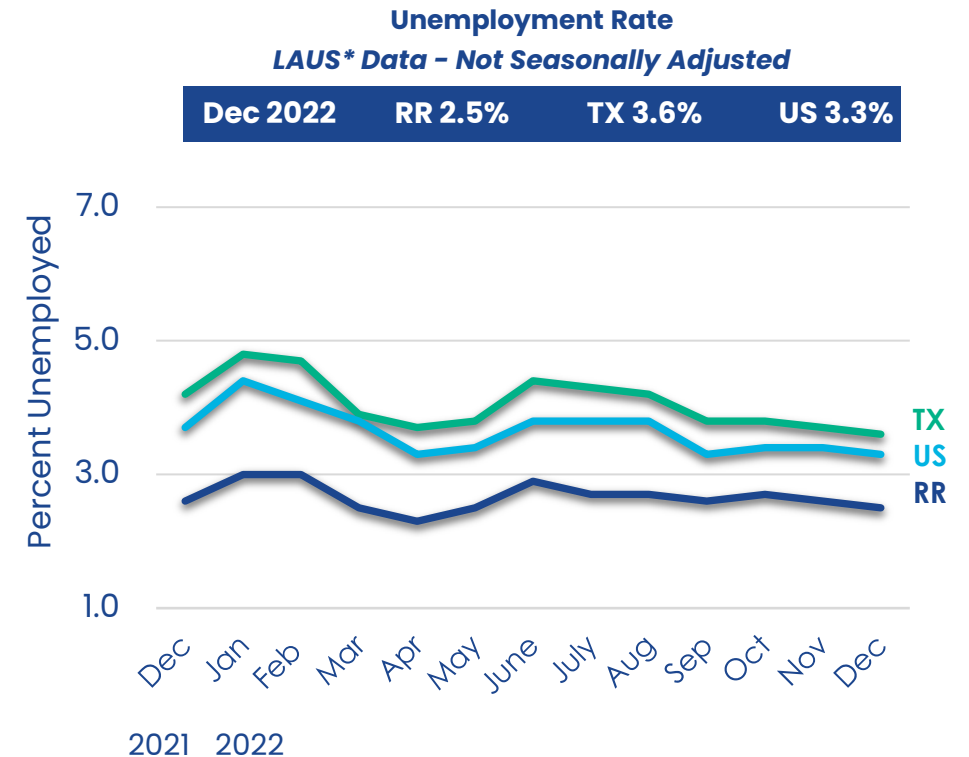

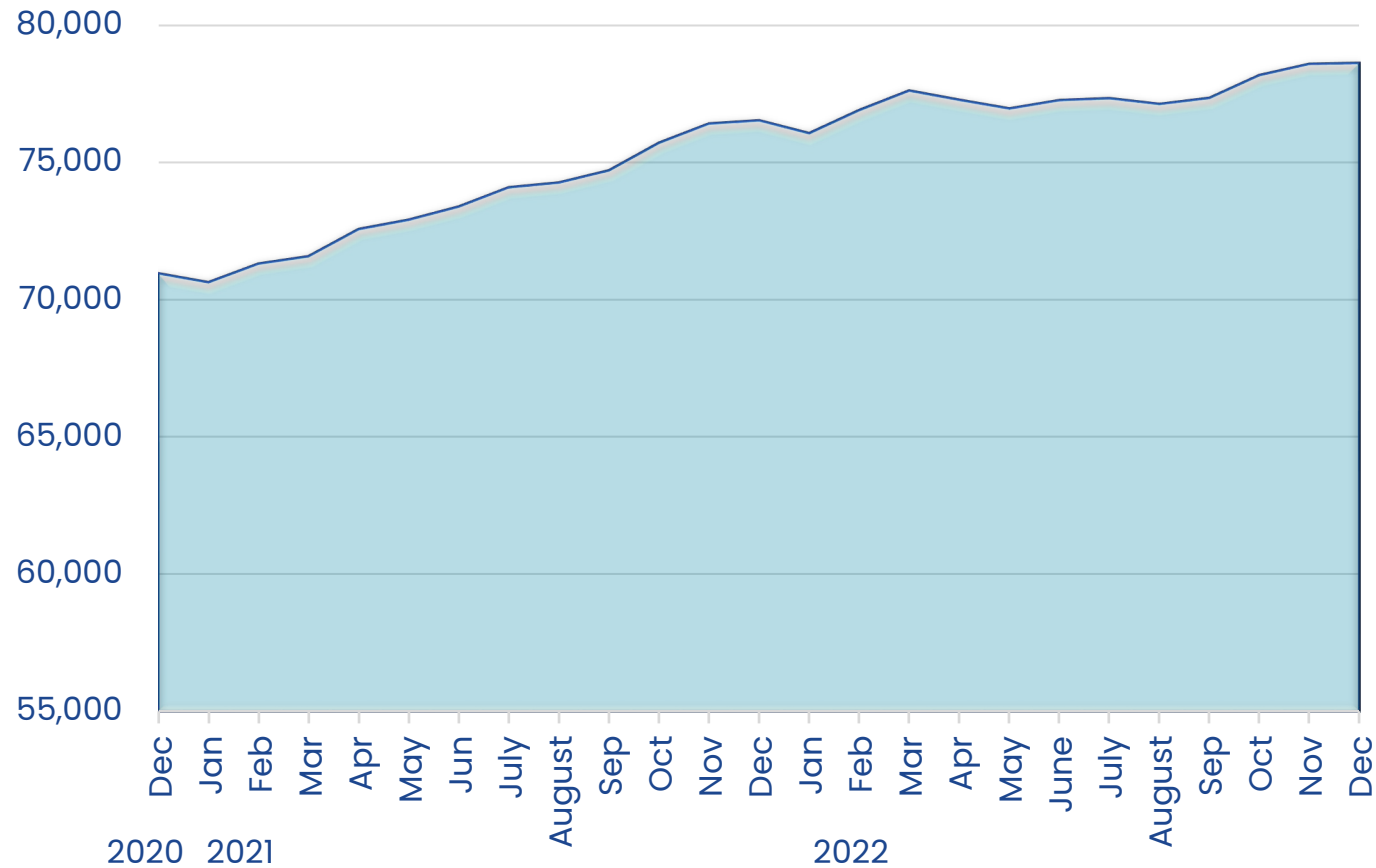

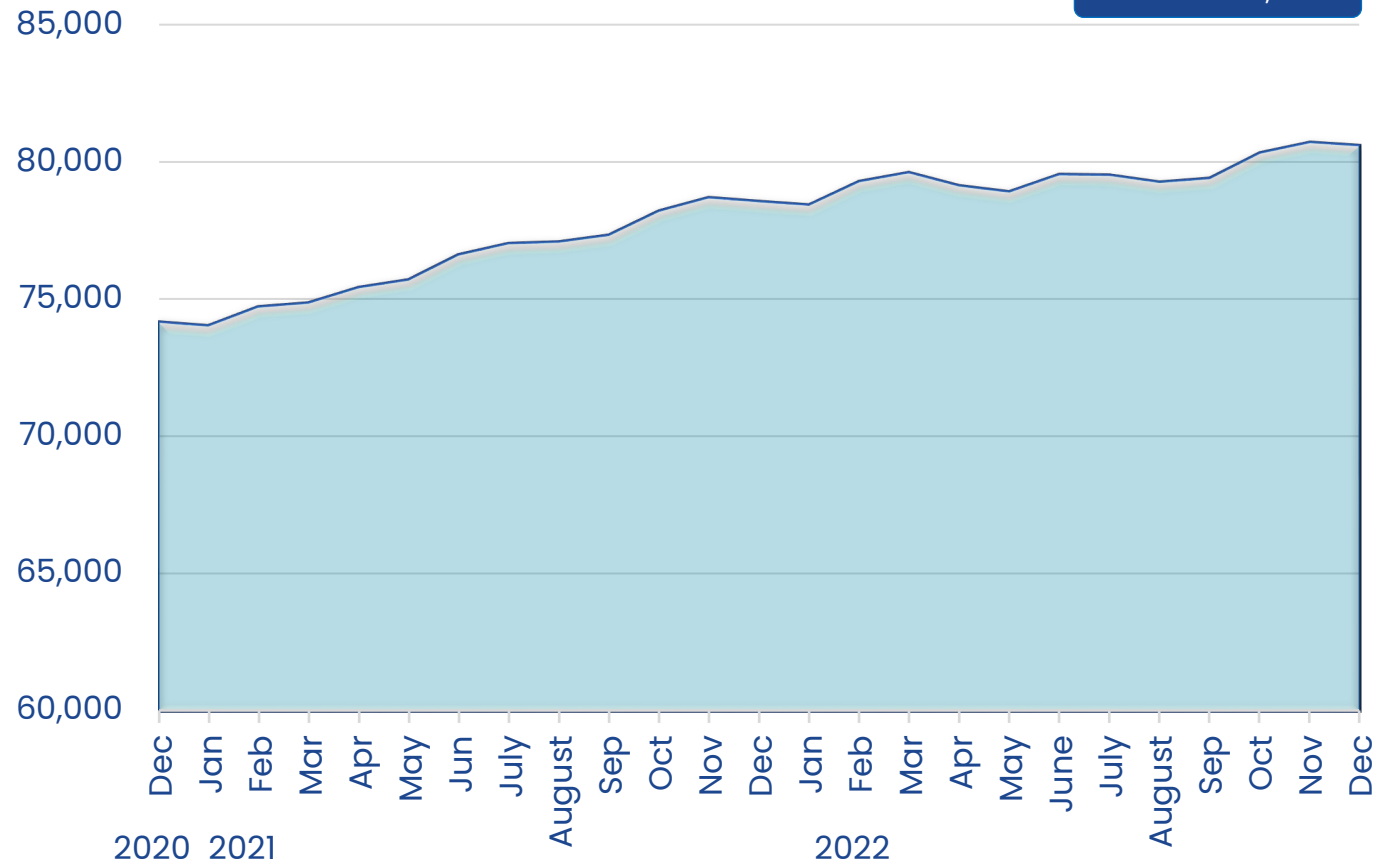

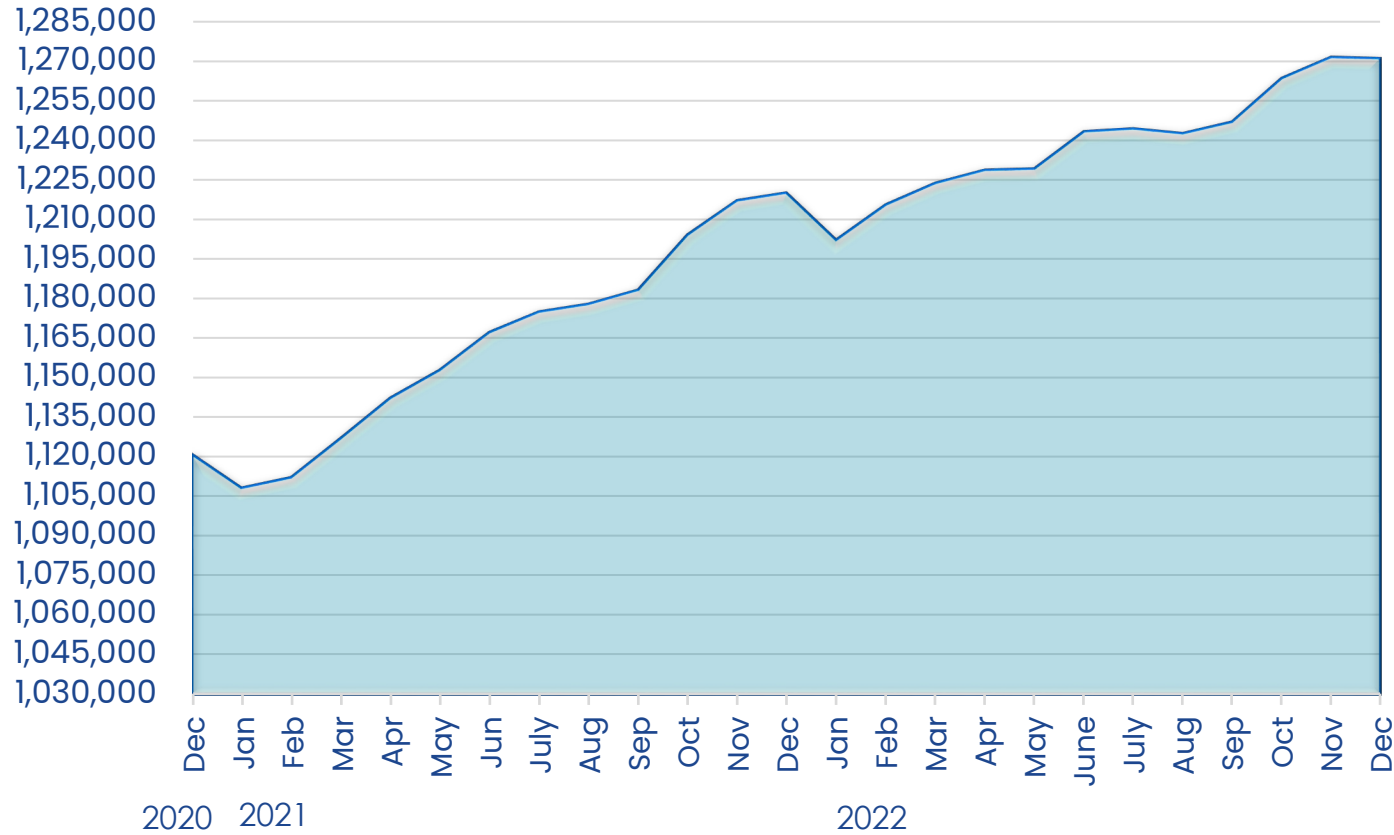




Economic Indicators – MSA Total Nonfarm Jobs

Dec 22= 1,271,100



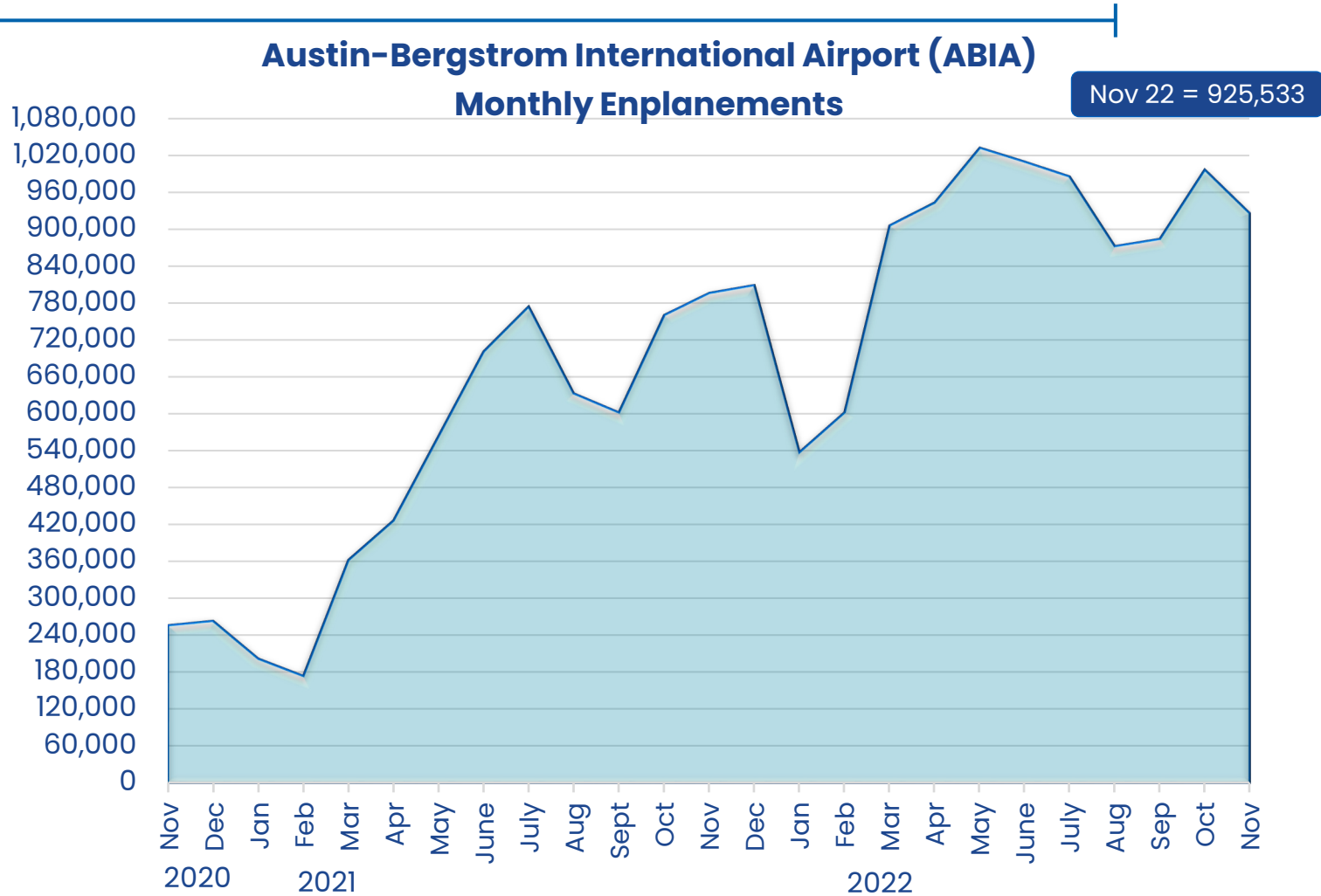

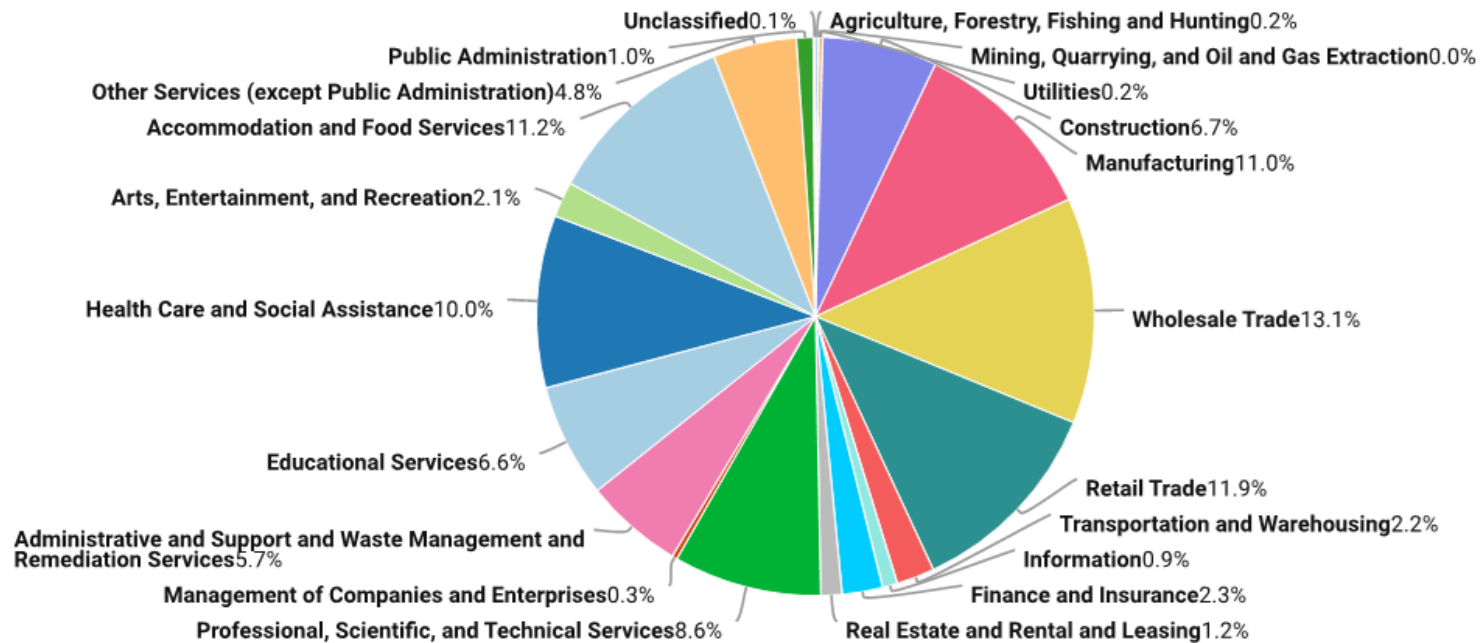
