ABOUT LEADERSHIP ROUND ROCK:

The mission of Leadership Round Rock is to develop leadership skills in individuals and to promote awareness of issues and opportunities that impact Round Rock. It is designed to provide participants with important information about topics such as the area's history, infrastructure, and educational composition, as well as the significance of involvement in and support for the community.

ELIGIBILITY & SELECTION:

- You must be a Chamber member to participate in Leadership Round Rock.
- Local businesses and organizations are encouraged to submit nominations and provide scholarships to employees with community leadership potential.
- Class size is limited. The Leadership Round Rock Selection Committee reviews applications, and applicants will be notified of their status in November, approximately two months before the program commences in January of next year.

REQUIREMENTS:

Participants are required to attend and actively engage in subject-specific sessions, mandatory retreat, and graduation ceremony. The 2023 calendar has been finalized and you can review the dates in the following sections.

Participants are also required to attend/participate in the following:

- A community service project (approximately 20 volunteer hours)
