YOUNG PROFESSIONALS

The Chamber's Young Professionals Program is designed to build and strengthen the young professional workforce in Round Rock. The Chamber is committed to offering events and programs that revolve around leadership development, educational resources and networking with likeminded individuals.

AMBASSADORS

Ambassadors of the Round Rock Chamber are members that represent the chamber at community events throughout the year. The group is tasked with gathering investor feedback and plays a pivotal role in Chamber ribbon cuttings. Ambassadors are an extension of the Chamber staff and are able to gain vital exposure for their companies.

This program is ideal for anyone who enjoys reaching out to new members, has the time and ability to attend ribbon cuttings, and wants additional exposure for their company.



LEADERSHIP ROUND ROCK

The mission of Leadership Round Rock is to develop leadership skills in individuals and promote awareness of issues and opportunities that impact Round Rock. It is designed to provide participants with important information about topics such as city history, infrastructure, and educational composition, as well as the significance of involvement in and support for the community.

Applications for the program open annually in the summer and applicants are notified of acceptance in November. The program duration is one calendar year. Tuition for the program ranges from \$825 to \$1,650 based on the participant's company's Chamber membership level. This program is ideal for anyone who wants to become more involved in the Round Rock community.



ASCEND

Ascend is an annual program of the Round Rock Chamber designed for emerging leaders who are equipped to serve the Round Rock community and are focused on personal, professional and leadership development.

Participants of this exclusive program will receive a deep dive into specific topics and issues that affect the community. In addition, class participants will have an opportunity to connect directly with Ascend Alumni and community mentors to set future leadership goals following program graduation. This program is ideal for graduates or the Leadership Round Rock program that would like to continue their personal and professional development.

Intercity Visit is an opportunity for community and business leaders in Round Rock to travel to another city of similar size and connect and collaborate with its leaders. The trip provides a forum for sharing ideas, successes, and other insights on how to drive prosperity for Round Rock.

ENTREPRENEURSHP COUNCIL

The Entrepreneurship Council is a group of members of the start-up and small business community, working in a supportive role for the Round Rock Chamber.
