



The Round Rock Chamber hosted the inaugural Round Rock Startup Day, a full day dedicated to celebrating innovation and entrepreneurship. This event brought together a diverse community of entrepreneurs, visionaries and trailblazers for a day dedicated to fostering creativity and collaboration.

Attendees had three unique ways to engage. The day began with the Buildership* Workshop, where selected participants took part in an immersive, hands-on experience designed to elevate their entrepreneurial skills. Following the workshop, breakout sessions offered an opportunity to dive deep into key topics for startups, covering everything from scaling strategies to funding insights. The day wrapped up with the Round Rock Pitch Competition, where entrepreneurs showcased their innovative ideas, competing for a grand prize that highlighted the region's commitment to fostering local talent. We were also fortunate enough to have Round Rock City Council Member, Michelle Ly, read a proclamation declaring May 2, 2024, Round Rock Startup Day.

BUSINESS ADVOCACY

As part of its Business Advocacy efforts—a key pillar of the Momentum program—the Round Rock Chamber proudly endorsed the successful passage of Round Rock ISD's 2024 Bond Propositions A, B and C. These critical investments will provide facility upgrades, modernized technology and infrastructure improvements to ensure students receive a high-quality education that prepares them for future careers.

Recognizing that strong schools are essential to workforce and talent development, the Chamber also hosted a public forum for candidates running for the three open Round Rock ISD Board of Trustees seats. This event gave candidates a platform to discuss their priorities and answer community-submitted questions on the future of education in Round Rock.

Through strategic advocacy and community engagement, the Chamber continues to champion pro-business policies and workforce development initiatives that strengthen the local economy and ensure a skilled workforce for the future.

Talent Development Council

The Round Rock Chamber hosted bimonthly Talent Development Council meetings, bringing together local education partners and organizations to build the talent pipeline in Central Texas. This included two industry roundtables connecting employers with workforce resources to better address the workforce needs of Round Rock businesses.
